APPOINTMENT PACKAGE FOR “K” VISA APPLICANTS

We have completed the preliminary processing of your “K” visa application. Because you informed us that you have all of the documents needed to apply for a “K” visa, we have scheduled you for an interview. Your interview will take place at the Consulate General in Ho Chi Minh City on the date specified in the cover letter. **If you cannot keep your appointment, please immediately notify the Consulate General in writing and complete a re-scheduled interview request form available at our office.** Please note that your rescheduled interview will normally not occur for at least three months after we receive this form and could be later depending on the current schedule.

YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING AT LEAST ONE WEEK BEFORE YOUR INTERVIEW:

FIRST: Go to the Quarantine Service of HCMC (40 Nguyen Van Troi Street, Phu Nhuan District, HCMC. Tel 84-8-844-5306) to obtain a vaccination assessment and any required vaccinations. Bring all of your vaccination records with you. The cost will be between VND 50,000 and VND 250,000 depending on your age and the required vaccinations.

SECOND: Complete your medical examination. You may receive your medical examination at one of two places:

1. Cho Ray Hospital, 201B Nguyen Chi Thanh Street, Ward 12, District 5, HCMC, Tel: 84-8-856-5703 Please enter through Thuan Kieu Gate and proceed to the Visa Medical Unit behind the main hospital building for your medical exam.
2. The International Organisation for Migration (IOM), 1B Pham Ngoc Thach Street, District 1, HCMC. Tel: 84-8-822-2058; 84-8-822-2057; 84-8-822-2061; 84-8-822-7511.

Both facilities will collect a fee of US \$60 for adults and children over the age of 15, US \$40 for children under the age of 15. At Cho Ray Hospital, you may use Vietnam dong to pay the fee; at IOM, you must use US dollars to pay the fee. Results are generally available in two days. The examiner will discuss the medical exam results with you and any follow-up treatment you may need. The examiner will give you a sealed envelope containing your medical exam results. **DO NOT PEN THIS ENVELOPE.** Bring the envelope to your interview. After your visa is issued, you will need to hand carry this envelope containing the x-ray film with you to the U.S.

THIRD: Go to the Visa Application Fee Payment Office at CitiBank (Room No.3, Ground floor, Sunwah building, 115 Nguyen Hue, District 1, HCMC) to pay your machine readable visa (MRV) application fee of US \$100. Hours of business at CitiBank are 8:30 to 11:30 and 13:00 to 15:30, Monday through Friday. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE AT THE PAYMENT LOCATION BEFORE 8:30 a.m.**

Each person intending to travel to the U.S., regardless of age, requires a separate application fee. CitiBank will issue you a receipt in duplicate that you must present at your visa interview. Other than the US \$100 MRV fee described above, there are no other visa fees for a “K” visa. Please note that the MRV application fee is NOT refundable.
