An appointment for your visa interview will not be scheduled unless we are in receipt of forms, DS-230 Part I, 2 x DS-156, DS-156k, 2 x DS-157, checklist DS-2001, and received the results of your medical examination.

DO NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES SEND ANY DOCUMENTS TO THIS OFFICE UNTIL YOU ARE SPECIFICALLY REQUESTED TO DO SO. A FINAL DETERMINATION CONCERNING THEIR ACCEPTABILITY CAN ONLY BE MADE AT THE TIME OF YOUR INTERVIEW. THIS WILL ALSO PREVENT LOSS OF DOCUMENTS AND YOUR HAVING TO OBTAIN DUPLICATES.

All fiancé(e) and K3/4 visa applicants must each pay a fee of \$240 prior to their interview. Please contact the Operator Assisted Information Service on 09042 450100 (calls cost £1.23/min) from BT landlines; some mobile and network providers may charge more. Payment is by credit or debit card - Visa, MasterCard or American Express; we do not accept Visa Electron or Maestro cards.

When communicating with this office, either by telephone or letter, you must provide your name and case number exactly as shown in this letter. If your name is spelled incorrectly, please notify us as soon as possible.
