- Other Documents such as: Bank Statements, leases, insurance, automobile registration, children's Birth certificates, any divorce decrees, Family photos and phone records.
- A government issued Identification, passport(s), to include any expired passports, and any and all immigration and State Department documents issued to you.

- **Bring certified photocopies of all documents you do not wish to surrender.**
- **If you do not speak English, please bring an adult disinterested third party interpreter to the interview.**
- **Failure to do may results in your interview being rescheduled.**
- **Also note that you may not leave the United States without advance parole permission from the USCIS.**
