You must supply the following additional documentation:

Original Affidavit of Support (Form I-864, I-864EZ or I-864W) from _____, the Sponsor who filed your immigrant visa petition. If both the sponsor's and their spouse's income and assets are to be used to meet minimum income requirements, your relative and their spouse must complete the I-864A, "Contract between Sponsor and Household Member." Your relative signs as "sponsor" and their spouse signs as "household member." www.uscis.gov

Your sponsor has not met the minimum income level required by Section 213A of the Immigration and Nationality Act. You will therefore need a **joint sponsor**, who must provide:

- o Original Affidavit of Support (Form I-864); further info can be found at www.uscis.gov
- o A copy of their most recent Individual Income Tax Return (IRS Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ) and most recent W2 Form.
- o A copy of their U.S. passport biographical data page, U.S. birth certificate, U.S. Naturalization Certificate or both sides of his/her "green card" (Form I-551).
- o A Contract between Sponsor and Household Member (Form I-864A), if applicable.

Signed copies of your sponsor's/joint sponsor's **U.S. federal income tax returns**, IRS Form 1040 (Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) for the most recent year, with all supporting schedules. IRS printouts are acceptable. We cannot accept corporate or state income tax returns. www.irs.gov

Evidence of your sponsor's **assets** (e.g. investments, savings, pensions, real estate less any mortgages, etc.), if sponsor's total income does not exceed 125 percent of the minimum income guideline.

Your sponsor needs to submit _____ **additional copies of the I-864**, one copy for each person who is immigrating.

- Proof that your sponsor meets the **U.S. domicile requirement**, which could include: proof of filing of U.S. taxes with domestic earned income, proof of property in the U.S., a signed copy of a lease in the U.S., proof of U.S. bank accounts or investments.
- A recent **job letter** (listing job title, current salary and dates of employment) and a copy of a recent pay slip. Note: JOB TRANSFERS to the US are acceptable, but JOB OFFERS are insufficient.
- Proof of relationship (photos, mails, invoices....).
