

## **Required Documents**

### **Passport: Original only**

- Your valid passport

### **DS-160 Non-immigrant Visa Electronic Application Form: Copy only**

- Complete [DS-160](#)
- Ensure you select “Australia, Sydney” as the location where you will be applying for this visa
- You must print the completed “Application form” to submit.

### **MRV Fee receipt for K Visa applicants: Copy only**

- This fee is not payable at/to our office.
- It can be paid [online](#) or at [Australia Post](#).
  - Please ensure you print and bring the receipt showing the amount you paid to submit.

### **Photograph: Original only**

- One [U.S. passport size photograph](#) (5cm x 5cm)
- Refer to our website for [a list of photographers](#)
- On the back of your photo
  - Print the date the photo was taken, *it must be less than 6 months old*
- Attach your photo to the DS-160 confirmation page
  - paperclip only

### **Revalidation Letter**

- Your I-129F petition may expire by the time you attend your final visa interview. To revalidate your petition, please have your U.S. citizen fiancé(e) provide you with a letter requesting that your petition be extended to a further 4 months from the approval date of the I-129F petition. This letter must be dated and signed by your fiancé(e) The letter from your U.S. citizen fiancé(e) should state their intention to still marry you within 90 days of your arrival into the U.S. with the K-1 visa and that you both are still free to marry.

### **Birth certificate: Original only**

The original birth certificate which must contain:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Place of birth
- Names of both parents (if applicable)

### **Unobtainable birth certificate: Original only**

Your birth record may not be obtainable because it was never officially recorded, it was destroyed or the appropriate government authority will not issue one.

- Obtain a certified statement from the appropriate government authority stating the reason your birth record is not available.
- In addition you must also obtain secondary evidence:
  - A baptismal certificate that contains the date and place of birth and both parent’s names (if applicable), providing the baptism took place shortly after birth
  - An adoption decree for an adopted child
  - An affidavit from a close relative, preferably the applicant’s mother, stating the date and place of birth, both parents names (if applicable), and the mother’s maiden name.

### **Termination of prior marriage(s): Original only**

- Final divorce decree

- Death certificate
- Annulment

**Australian police certificates: Original only**

You must apply for an Australian Federal Police Certificate (AFP). Australian police certificates are valid for 12 months from date of issuance.

Your certificate can be based on a name check or fingerprint check.

If it's based on a name check, it must contain all aliases previously and presently used. Failure to provide a name check certificate with all aliases may result in the consular officer refusing your application for a police certificate based on a fingerprint check.

**Other County(ies) Police Certificate(s) (if applicable):**

If you answer YES to the following, the police certificate is required from that country.

- 1a. Since turning 16, I have resided in another country for 6 months or more.  YES
- 1b. At that time I held / currently hold citizenship of that country.  YES

*Or;*

2. Since turning 16, I have resided in another country (besides Australia and the U.S.) for 12 months or more?  YES

Note: U.S. police certificates are not required.

**Court and/or Prison Record(s): Original only**

If you have been convicted of a crime you must provide the record, regardless of any subsequent amnesty, pardon or other act of clemency.

Records may include:

- Complete information regarding the circumstance surrounding the crime of which the applicant was convicted, and
- The disposition of the case, including sentence or other penalty or fine imposed.
- The statute under which you were convicted.

**Military record(s): Original only**

- A record of your military service must be provided.

**Translation(s): Original only**

All documents not in English must be accompanied by an English translation

- The translator must be competent to translate
- The translation must be from the original document
- The translation must be signed and dated by the translator

**Form I-134 Affidavit of Support: Original only**

- [Form I-134](#) must have an original signature
- Submit the required [supporting documentation](#)

**Medical Examination Report: Original only**

- Arrange for a medical examination with one of our approved physicians.
