To schedule an interview appointment:

Please sign and mail to us the Checklist from the Packet 3. We no longer schedule appointments in person. The beneficiary will receive an appointment letter by mail. For immigrant visa cases for which the Packet 3 was processed by the National Visa Center (NVC), we will send an appointment letter to the beneficiary as soon as we receive the file from the NVC.
