This conversation took place when my wife was on a business trip to the UK.



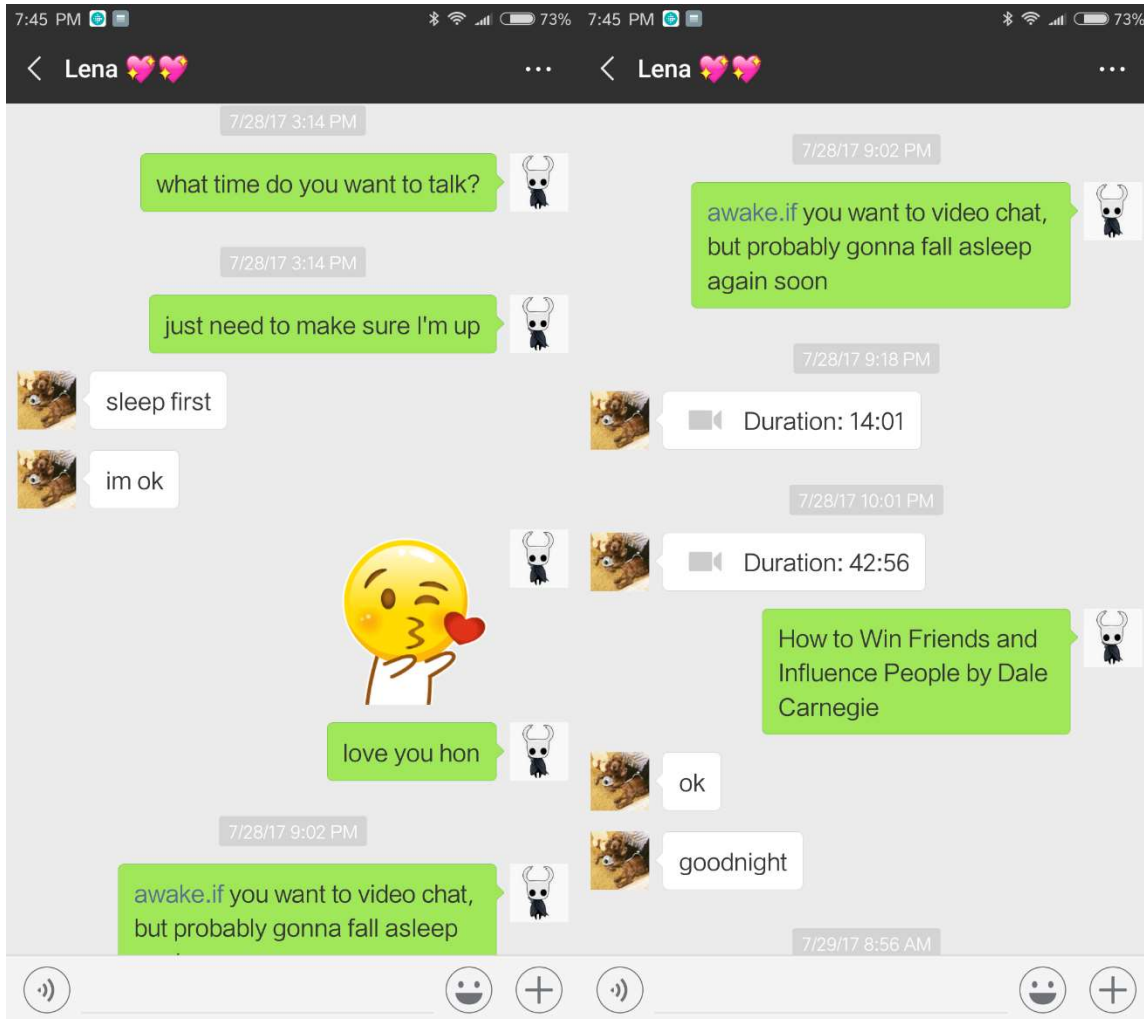

This conversations happened around the time my wife was diagnosed with breast cancer.

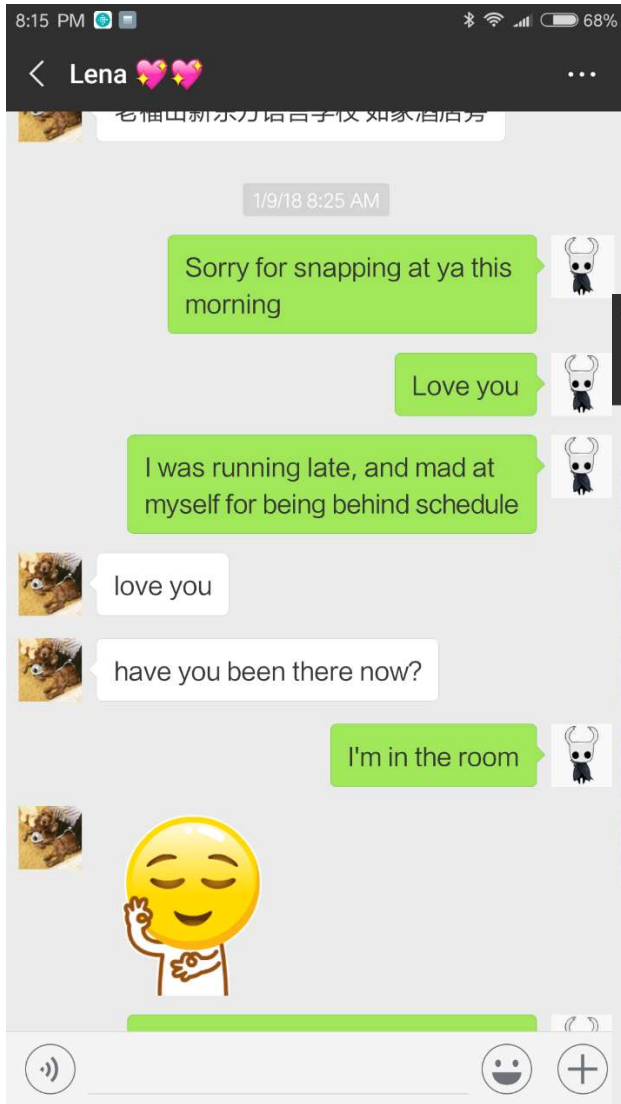

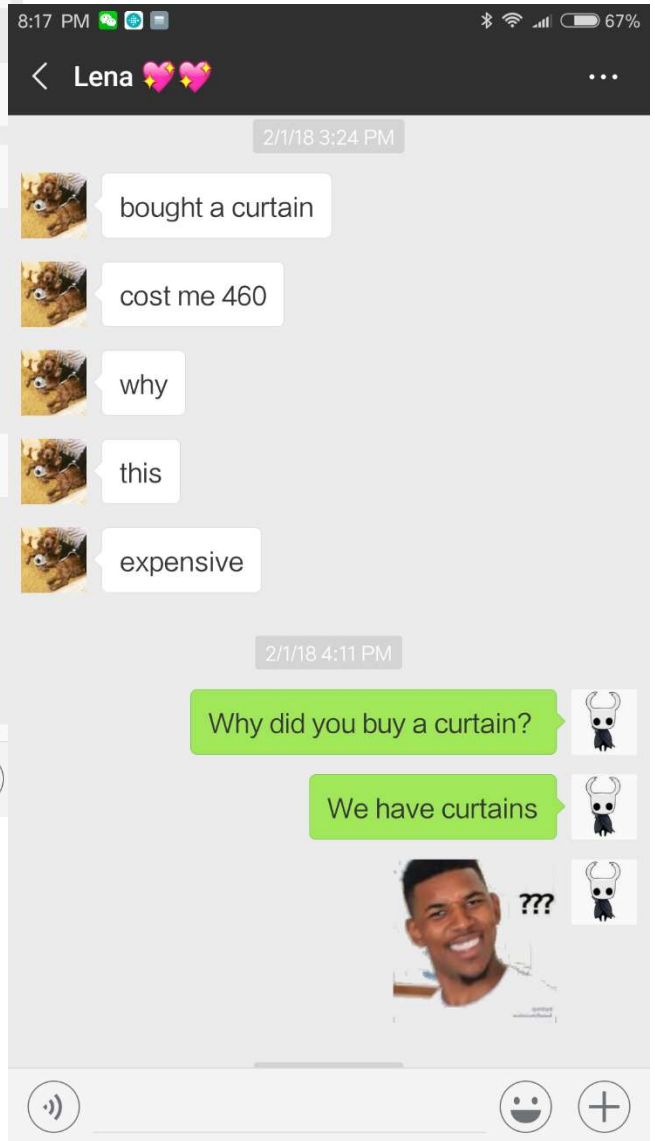

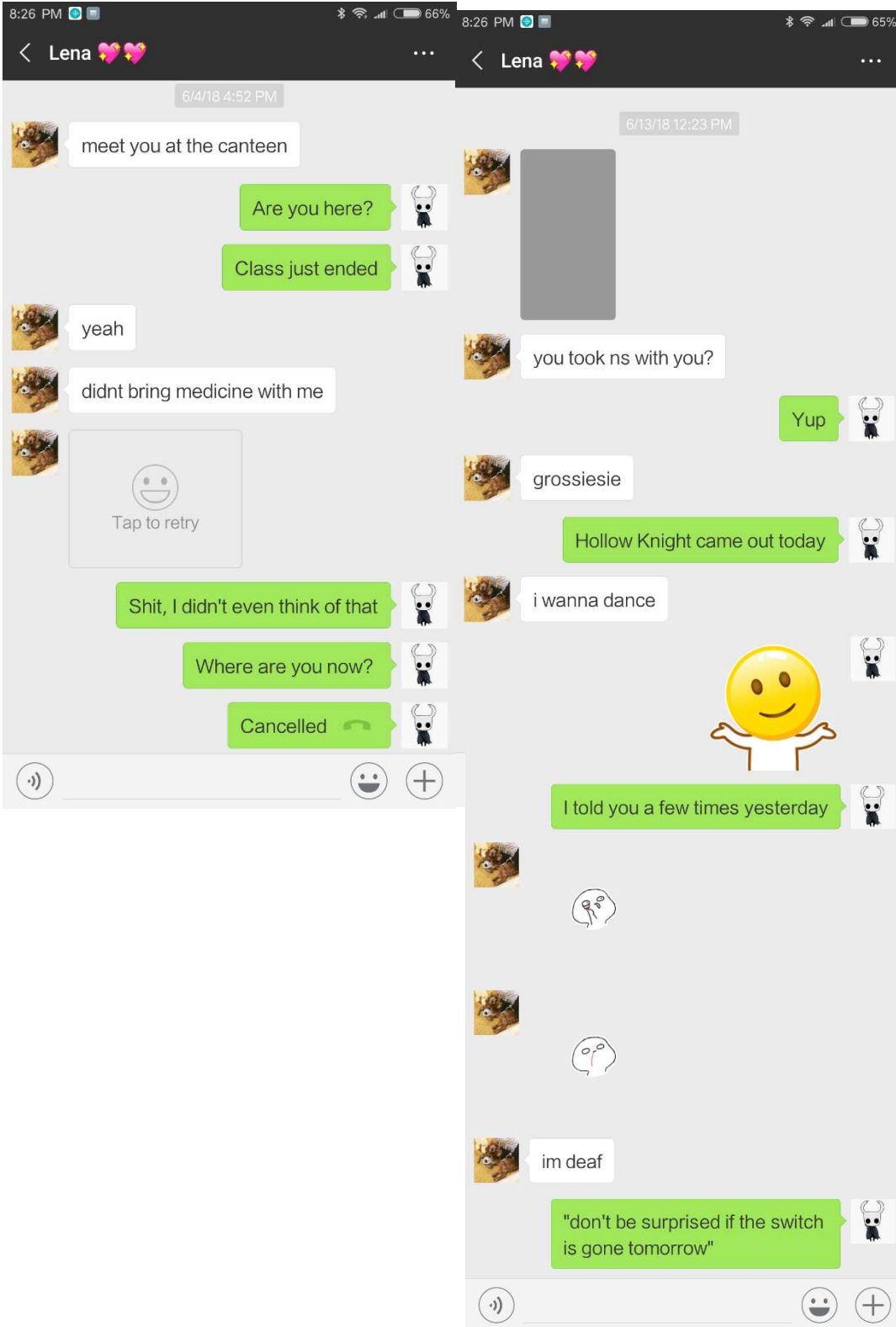
