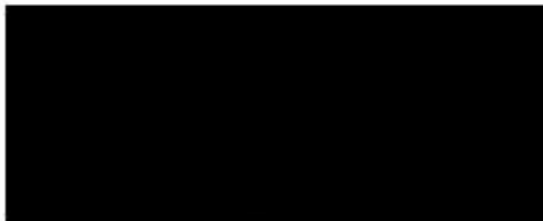

You are required to bring the following documents with you (as applicable).

- Two Forms DS-156 (All questions on the form must be answered)
- Form DS-157 (All questions on the form must be answered - This form is not required for Female applicants)
- Form DS-230 (Part-I) (All questions on the form must be answered)
- Birth Certificate (Original, English translation and one copy of each)
- Marriage Certificate (Original, English translation and one copy of each)
- Death Certificate if previous spouse is deceased (Original, English translation and copy of each)
- Divorce Certificate if applicant or petitioner previously married and divorced (Original, English translation and copy of each)
- Evidence of your relationship to the petitioner, such as wedding and family photographs, original school records, the petitioner's old passports, letters, phone bills, etc.
- Credible evidence of financial support in the United States, such as:
 - Form I-134 (Affidavit of Support) from the petitioner or other relative/friend;
 - Copies of the sponsor's federal tax returns (Form 1040) for the previous year;
 - A job letter or copy of business license if sponsor is self-employed; and
 - Evidence of the sponsor's assets.
- Passport (Valid for 12 months beyond the anticipated visa interview date. A Separate passport for each applicant is required)
- Medical report from a panel physician (Vaccinations are not required).
- Police Clearance Certificate from the nearest police station.
- Photographs (Two front face view photographs according to the specifications attached).
- \$100 application fee (or equivalent Pakistani rupees) for each applicant. Please bring exact change.
