Dear Visa Applicant:

Your application for a nonimmigrant visa has been refused per Section 221(g) of the U.S. Immigration and Nationality Act and requires additional information before we can make a final determination in your visa application.

Please answer the following questions to the best of your ability and submit the information via email to mumbaitech@state.gov within one week of your interview using the subject line "CEAC Barcode -- Your Last Name, Your First Name" (example: AA000DGF1A -- Reddy, Raghu). We will not be able to process your case if we do not receive all the documentation in one email in the required file format. Your visa application will remain in refused status until you submit the requested information.

Please provide the following information in one Word document:

- (1) Travel history over the last 15 years, including source of funding for travel (E.g. 01-Jan-2001, Sri Lanka, and NAME OF SPONSOR/SHIPPING COMPANY)
- (2) Names and dates of birth of siblings; children; current and former husband/wife.
- (3) Addresses and phone numbers during the last 15 years, if different from the current address.
- (4) List prior passport numbers and country of issuance.
- (5) Prior occupation (title and description), employers, employers' addresses, dates of employment, and phone numbers from the last 15 years.
- (6) Email addresses used during the last five years.
- (7) Any social media user names or handles (e.g. Facebook name, Instagram user account) used in the last five years.

Please be aware that this processing typically takes weeks. We are unable to provide a more specific completion date. You do not need to return in person to the consulate unless you are contacted again by a representative of the consulate requesting your physical presence. You will receive an email when the process is complete with instructions on how to submit your passport.
