Only a consular officer can decide if you qualify for a visa, following your interview. As we can't guarantee an outcome by any set date, we caution you against resigning from work, giving up accommodation in the UK or making final travel plans unless you have received your passport containing a valid immigrant visa. No expedited visa processing service is available.
