

If you can, carry the following documents to N-400 interview.

- 1) **Green card**
- 2) **Interview letter**
- 3) **Passports (old and new)**
- 4) **Driver's License**
- 5) **Copy of filed application**
- 6) **Print-out of details showing all international travel during the last 5 years, including dates, countries visited, and # of days outside of the U.S.**
- 7) Print-out of details showing all international travel subsequent to filing, including dates, countries visited, and # of days outside of the U.S.
- 8) Selective Services Letter - <https://www.sss.gov/Home/Men-26-and-OLDER> (takes 6-8 weeks to get, so get this requested early in the process.)
- 9) Extra passport photos
- 10) **Marriage certificate if married**
- 11) Wife's birth certificate
- 12) Your own birth certificate
- 13) **social security card**
- 14) Children's birth certificate
- 15) **4 years of IRS tax transcripts and 1 year of account transcript**
- 16) W-2 forms
- 17) Employment Letter
- 18) 3 months of bank statements, incl joint accounts if marriage based
- 19) **If Global Priority, copy of Global Priority card. I had also taken pictures of the slip that got printed out by the kiosk before handing them in to Customs Officers**
- 20) Lease agreement or Title deed for residence
- 21) Utility Bills
- 22) Screenshot of UPS/FedEx delivery date and time of N-400 application, (esp if filing 90 days early) and a screenshot of USCIS calculator showing the earliest date you can file N-400.
- 23) DMV certified full history of Drivers Record
- 24) Any court dispositions for citations, including all speeding and parking tickets.
- 25) Extra copies of passports, DL, and green card.
- 26) **Pen and pencil**
- 27) Breath mints
- 28) Calculator (to help the IO add up the travel dates)
