Enclosed is form N - 400 along with supporting documents to include DD Forms 1278 and 1614 so that I may apply for Naturalization under section 319 (b) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act as the spouse of a US Government Employee who is being reassigned overseas. My husband, Joe Civilservant currently employed by the US Army at the US Army Messkit Repair Activity in Arlington, VA has accepted a new position with American Forces Chowline Study Group in Vicenza, Italy with a reporting date on or about 13 April 2008.

We are authorized concurrent travel and I along with our daughter will accompany my husband on his assignment. I am fully aware of the large amount of applications that you have in the system and that it is possible that it may not be able to be adjudicated prior to our departure. I currently have a case pending in your office for the renewal of my Permanent Resident Card under application number EAC0000000000. I have attached a copy of the notice of action to this packet for your reference. You will see that I have sent a copy of my expired card along with the Notice of Action extending my status for one more year.
