

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE DAY OF YOUR US VISA MEDICAL

You need to ensure you bring the following:

1. **Current valid passport**
 - If you have multiple passports, bring the passport you are using for your visa application
 - If your passport has been kept at the US Consulate, bring another photo ID (i.e. driver's licence or photo card)
2. **Passport Photos**
 - 6 identical passport photos (4 for children 14 years and under) – please ensure these are cut to Australian passport photo size
3. **Express post envelope**
 - 1 large (A4) prepaid express post envelope
4. **A health summary**
 - Request this from your local GP, it must include your medical history and current medications
5. **Immunisation records and/or serology reports**
 - You may have provided this information prior to your appointment but please bring the original documents on the day as they will need to be checked
 - Request this from your local GP
 - If you have travelled previously and been given a yellow book or any other form of immunisation record bring this
6. **Confirmation letter from the US Consulate**
 - If you have been to the interview, bring the letter the consulate given to you after the interview.

Other important information:

- The medical will take approximately **3 hours** (including chest Xray and blood tests). Please ensure you have put aside enough time.
- If you have **small children** please ensure you bring refreshments and something to occupy them.
- **A urine sample is required.** If possible do not pass urine 1 hour before your scheduled appointment and ensure your fluid intake is adequate. For females 15 years and over do not use any vaginal creams or douches 24 hours prior.
