You can come for the US Medical examination as a **walk-in** client from **9:00AM to 4:00PM**. The entire process, including examinations, investigation, and vaccination will take approximately **3-4 hours**.

We are located at the **M Floor, Al Safia Building, Salahuddin Road, Deira, Dubai, UAE**.

We are open on **all days except Sundays and Public holidays**. **Kindly call to check the availability of the panel physician**.

### DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENT

**The following documents are required for the US Medical:**

- Original Passports and four copies of your passport
- 6 passport size photographs (2x2 inches) with white background
- Vaccination Record in English (if any) including WHO certified COVID vaccination record

**If you are a resident of UAE, above 12 years applicants must present WHO certified COVID vaccination record. Without the Covid vaccination record we can't proceed with the medical examination.**

- Embassy Appointment Letter
- Downloaded and filled DS260 form (embassy letter with bar code)

**You will be required to provide the following:**

- Present Address of Residence and Postal Code of Residence
- Intended US City and State of residence
- Intended US Address and postal code
- Email address

**Please bring your eyeglasses/contact lenses (if any), medical records, and current medication list (if any).**

**Vaccinations**, if required, are charged separately depending on the type of vaccination.

## TESTS

Applicants **18-24 years** of age are required to undergo testing for gonorrhoea. **24 years includes 24 years + 11 months + 29 days**. Applicants aged less than 18 years or greater than 24 years must be tested if there is a reason to suspect infection with gonorrhoea.

Applicants **18-44 years** of age are required to undergo testing for syphilis. **44 years includes 44 years + 11 months + 29 days**. Applicants aged less than 18 years or greater than 44 years must be tested if there is a reason to suspect infection with syphilis.

Applicants **15-17 years** of age and 45 years and above are required to undergo chest x-ray and consultation. **17 years includes 17 years + 11 months + 29 days**.

Applicants **25-44 years** of age are required to undergo chest x-ray, laboratory and consultation. **44 years includes 44 years + 11 months + 29 days**.

**Chest x-ray is mandatory for all applicants 15 years of age and above**. There will be no exemption nor substitute for this requirement.

Children applicants between **2 years and 14 years & 6 months** are required to undergo a blood test for tuberculosis\*. This test is reported after four days.

\*Tuberculosis test is required only for some nationalities and resident holders based on WHO/the World Bank statistics reported by 2017.

\*U.A.E. nationals and residents of the U.A.E are not required tuberculosis test. For example, Iranian national who is resident of Iran or resident of U.A.E not required Tuberculosis test.

## COMPLETION OF REPORTS

**Due to the high volume of US Medical requests**, reports are taking approximately **10-15 days** to complete. **The option to expedite the report is available**, but the decision will be made by the Panel Physician. **If the patient itself is healthy**, an expedited report is available **3-5 days** after the medical is completed. Please notify reception on the day of your medical that you will be requesting an expedited report.

The completed reports will be available for collection, and the **applicant will be informed of the date and time for collection** during the physical examination by the physician or the assistant nurse.

**Any abnormal test result** would require further evaluation/investigation and the result will be delayed. In such event you will be advised on the possible availability of your result.

In case of certain **abnormalities in chest x-ray** which require further investigation (sputum smear and culture for AFB), issuance of the report will be delayed by 8-10 weeks.
