ATTENTION IMMIGRANT VISA APPLICANT:

On the day of your medical exam at Visa Medicals, you will also need to attend the U.S. Embassy for an in-person document review between 12:00-1:00 PM.

Note, this is separate from your NVC appointment with the consular officer.

During this embassy appointment, immigration staff will:

- Verify your documents
- Take your biometrics (photo and fingerprints)
- Ensure your case is documentarily complete, in preparation for your NVC Scheduled interview.

You must bring all the documents below, required for your immigrant visa application directly to the Embassy after your medical exam – Certificates MUST be original or a certified copy.

- **All Valid Passports**
- **1 passport sized photo** - 1 for each applicant
- **Birth certificate** - UK birth certificates MUST be the Long form version which lists at least one parents' name.
- **Petitioners Original Birth certificate** –for IR5 (Parents of U.S. citizen) and F4 (Siblings of U.S. citizen)
- **Marriage certificate**
- **Divorce Decree/Death certificate**
- **UK ACRO Police certificate - Required for ALL applicants aged 16 years or older**
- **Foreign Police Certificates- From countries where:**
 - You have lived for more than 12 months after the age of 16
 - The country of your citizenship.
 - Any country where you have been arrested.

If Applicable:

- **Adoption certificate**
- **Change of Name Deed Poll/ Statutory Declaration**
- **Military record**

Once your case has been reviewed by immigration staff and determined to be documentarily complete, your original documents will be sealed and returned to you. Confirming you are prepared for your next (NVC) appointment with the Consular Officer.
